1. RULES

1.1. The event will be run under a set of guidelines stated in the Sailing Instructions prior to the event commencing

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1. Eligible classes – WASZP 8.2 and WASZP 6.9

2.2. The Official Event website www.gps-waszp.com has links to the upload your session and post your session within the event

3. FEES

3.1. The fee is free

4. FORMAT

The event will have a combination of SailGP, other professional sailors and Amateurs (WASZP) sailors all sailing WASZPs. All sailors must sail a WASZP and log their track on the WASZP GPS website, the website does a great job of verifying the speeds/distances however you must be able to provide further verification if your speeds/times if they are questioned. Either a photo of the day (dated) with you, your GPS and your WASZP or another person who can verify your session. Participants can lodge more than once session during the event window. If you are doing the wrong thing, you will be caught so don't even think about it.

5. SCHEDULE – You can sail on any day during the event period



6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. The sailing instructions will be launched on the 1st of September and will be available www.waszp.com/events

7. VENUE

8. SCORING

8.1. There will be 3 disciplines that will be scored 1) average speed 2) Fastest 250m run 3) 1/2 hour average speed/distance covered

8.2. The participants will be scored across the 3 disciplines and will receive a rank in each discipline

8.3. The participant will then receive a series score based off their 3 scores (each discipline)

8.4. There will be NO Discards

9.1. The best placed AMATUER will receive the ultimate prize of 2x Spectator tickets to the SailGP event of your choice and a ride on an F50
